Geography This project has a strong geography focus. We will go on a journey around the world comparing the United Kingdom and Hawaii, as well as China and the Middle East, looking at the geography and culture of these countries. We will be exploring and creating our own maps. We will be thinking about the cultural traditions of different countries and how they make people feel like they belong.

Art / Design and Technology We will be creating our own Chinese lanterns to celebrate Chinese New Year. After half term we will be creating some Hawaiian themed art work using different materials to paint with.

Maths We will be continuing to develop our knowledge and understanding of numbers within 10. We will look at combining two groups together to begin adding numbers. We will also be looking at number patterns including doubling and odd and even numbers. We will also continue to develop our understanding of measuring, including height, weight, and capacity.

English This term we will be continuing to develop our phonics knowledge, using this knowledge to help us write simple captions and sentences. We will be reading a variety of books including Naughty Bus, Emma Jane's Aeroplane and Katie In London

Music This half term we will be listening to and appraising Hawaiian, African and Chinese music.

Science Our focus is animals. We will be looking at different types of animals from around the world, including the countries we are learning about.

ICT We will be continuing to explore technology throughout our daily provision activities.

RE We will be thinking about the question: Why do Christians put a cross in an Easter Garden?
