William Wilberforce
(1759-1833)

Wilberforce was a British politician and leader of the movement to end the slave trade. Wilberforce's faith in Jesus Christ changed him from a careless, wealthy young man to compassionate public servant. He developed and used his gifts of leadership and persuasion to champion countless efforts to better society.
