

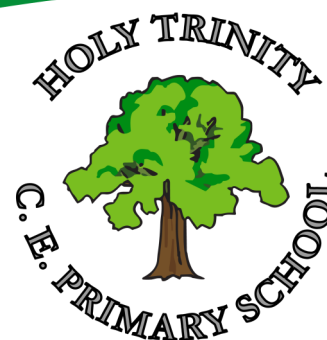

WILLOW CLASS NEWS!

This week in Willow Class we have started our Mini Beast topic with the story *SuperWorm* by Julia Donaldson. We have enjoyed sharing the book together and participating in activities linked to the story.
